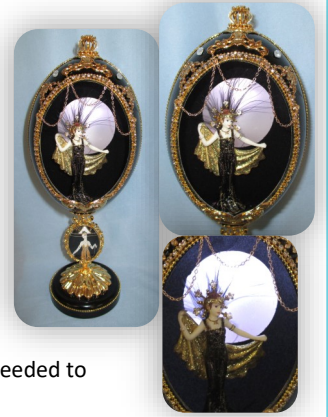

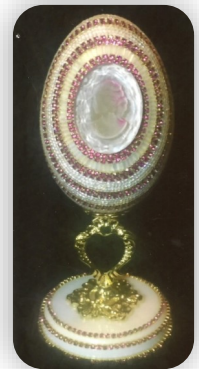

Ever wondered how you get something through the openings in a spiral egg? Then have a go at making this Goose egg. Five butterflies are positioned inside and one escaped to the bottom of the stand. 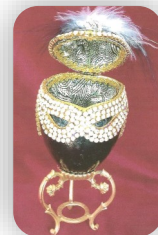
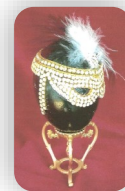

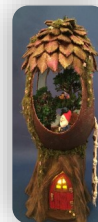
